What is EURES?

The purpose of EURES is to provide information, advice and recruitment/placement (job-matching) services for the benefit of workers and employers as well as any citizen wishing to benefit from the principle of the free movement of persons.

The EURES Portal offers more than 1,400,000 vacancies and information about the European labour market.

EURES has a human network of more than 1,000 EURES advisers that are in daily contact with jobseeker and employers across Europe. In Sweden there are around 60 EURES Advisers.

Today the EURES network is a cooperation between the European Commission and the Public Employment Services in EU/EEA and Switzerland.

Swedish language skills will improve your chances

Swedish employers are looking for skilled workers within several sectors, for example engineering, ICT, healthcare, construction, hospitality and industry. In some sectors, such as ICT or to work as a chef, speaking English might be sufficient. In other sectors learning Swedish is necessary and will greatly improve your opportunities to find a job in Sweden.
